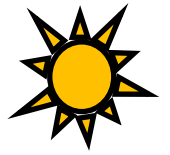

Project Day Descriptions

Calligraphy Project Day—June 5th 1:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m. Cost: \$5.00 *Limited to 12 participants.*

Participants will learn the decorative writing of calligraphy. Participants will get to rewrite a quote, poem, or pledge to submit into the 4-H Youth Expo in July. Calligraphy Projects can be entered into the 4-H Youth Expo in July under 4-H Arts & Crafts— Drawing.

Pen and Ink Project Day—June 5, 3:00 p.m.- 4:30 p.m. Cost: \$5.00 *Limited to 12 participants.*

Create an artistic Pen and Ink drawing with club leader, Bessie Bain. Pen and Ink Project can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Arts & Crafts— Drawing.

Cloverbuds Ceramic Painting - June 12th, 3:00 p.m.-4:30p.m. Cost: \$15.00 *Limited to 12*

Cloverbuds Participants. Paint a ceramic frog or turtle that you can enjoy displayed in your home. Cloverbuds Ceramic Painting can be entered into the 4-H Expo under Cloverbuds.

This project is open to Cloverbuds only.

Ceramic Painting - June 15th, 1:00 p.m.-2:30p.m. Cost: \$15.00 *Limited to 12 participants.* Paint a ceramic dog that you can enjoy displayed in your home. Ceramic Painting can be entered into the 4-H Expo in July under 4-H Home Environment— Unit II

Cupcake Decorating Project Day – June 16, 1:00 p.m.–4:00 p.m. Cost: \$12.00 *Limited 12*

participants. Learn how to decorate cupcakes using butter cream icing . Completed projects will be taken home until the 4-H Youth Expo in July. Cupcake Decorating Projects can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Trends- 4-H Cupcakes.

Sewing Camp – June 19 - June 21, 9:30 p.m.- 2:30 p.m. Cost: FREE *Limited 10 participants.* Open to all sewing units, beginner and advanced. Participants should bring a sack lunch. A supply list will be provided with registration. (Parent Volunteers are welcome to stay and help with the project.) Sewing Projects can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Sewing.

Leather Project Day—June 22nd, 9:00 a.m.— 11:00 a.m. *Limited 20 participants.* Youth will create a unique leather project using various stamping tools and techniques. All supplies needed to complete this project will be provided. Participants may choose only one leather project to complete. Project 1: Billfold, \$10.00 Project 2: Belt, \$10.00 – Project 3: Wristband and Key Chain, \$6.00. Leather Projects can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Arts and Crafts- Leather Crafts. *This project is open to Cloverbuds. Parents/ Guardians of Cloverbuds must attend workshop to assist youth.*

Computer Drawing Project Day - June 26th, 10:00a.m. - 11:30a.m. Cost: \$5.00 *Limited to 10*

participants. Youth will learn the concepts and work to create a computer drawing project, a new addition to the 4-H Arts and Crafts Division. Participants will go home with a jump drive of any artwork they have completed or started and all exhibits can be entered in the 4-H Youth Expo under 4-H Arts and Crafts - Computer Drawing. Five laptops are available for use on a first, come first served basis, otherwise you must provide your own laptop.

Upcycling Project Day - June 26th, 1:00p.m. - 2:30p.m. Cost: \$15.00. *Limited to 15 participants.*

Youth will create an upcycled clock utilizing a personal touch). Cost includes the clock kit and back and participants are asked to bring 12 small items that can represent the 12 numbers around a clock face (such as a deck of cards, dominoes or something other small to represent the numbers). This project will be eligible to be entered into the 4-H Youth Expo under 4-H Kentucky 4-H Trends.

Project Day Descriptions

Electric Project Day Level 2 – June 27th, 9:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Cost: \$20.00 *Limited to 5 participants and must have previously completed an Electric Project Day in the past two years.* This project day is offered for any youth who have completed the Electric Project Day in the past two years. Participants will learn how to complete an advanced electric project utilizing concepts utilized in previous project days. Completed project can be entered into the 4-H Youth Expo under 4-H Electric.

Photography Project Day - June 28th, 10:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m., Cost: \$10.00. **Limited to 20 Participants.** Participants will spend time learning photography concepts and then head outside to practice on a guided photography walk around Falling Springs Park. A camera is required and five are available to be reserved on a first come, first served basis. All participants will go home with an SD card with their pictures on it and can enter those pictures in the 4-H Youth Expo under photography.

Flower/ Vegetable Garden Project Day – June 29, 9:00 a.m.–10:00 a.m. Cost: \$15.00 **Limited 15 participants.** 4-H members may choose to participate in one or both parts. The first session will focus on flowering annuals, while the second will focus on vegetables. Photographs of the completed project will be taken. *All materials are provided for this class.* Completed projects will then be taken home and cared for until the 4-H Youth Expo in July. Flower/ Vegetable Garden Projects can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Horticulture and Plant Science. *This project is open to Cloverbuds.*

Dish Garden Project Days– June 29th, 10:00 a.m.– 11:00 a.m. Cost: \$10.00 **Limited 15 participants.** Participants will learn about succulent plants and what kind of soil they need to live in to survive. Participants will plant their dish gardens and then be able to take them home and care for them until the 4-H Youth Expo in July. *All materials are provided for this class.* Dish Garden Project Days can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Horticulture and Plant Science– Dish Garden. *This project is open to Cloverbuds.*

Herb Container Garden Project Day– June 29th, 11:00 a.m.– 12:00 p.m. Cost: \$10.00 **Limited 15 participants.** Participants will learn about herbs and how they can use herbs in the kitchen. Youth will plant herbs into a container and then be able to take them home and cared for until the 4-H Youth Expo in July. *All materials are provided for this class.* Herb Container Garden Projects can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Horticulture and Plant Science– Herb Container Garden. *This project is open to Cloverbuds.*

Kitchen Boot Camp—July 5th– 7th, 1:00 p.m.-3:30 p.m. Cost: \$10.00 **Limited 12 participants.** Do you love to cook? Then this workshop is for you! 4-H members will learn to read recipes, practice food safety, food preservation, knead bread, measure ingredients, and practice basic cutting skills. During this three day camp, youth will make oatmeal muffins, rich chocolate cake, and make salsa. Kitchen Boot Camp Projects can be entered into the Expo in July under 4-H Food Exhibits/Food Preservation Exhibits.

Bicycle Rodeo - July 26th, 10:00a.m. **No participant limit.** Join us for our annual Bicycle Rodeo, held at the Woodford County Extension Office. This is an opportunity for bike riders to show their bicycle skills while competing in a contest. Junior and Senior category winners advance to the Kentucky State Fair in August where they compete with youth from across the state. Cost is free but must have your own bicycle and helmet. Contest includes both a written and skills test. Please ask for testing materials to review prior to the contest.
